Hoosier Drag Tire Rollout (Circumference) Measuring Procedure

Roll out is the number of inches the tire rolls before it has traveled back to its initial starting point.

Measurement Procedure:

- 1. Once tire is mounted to wheel inflate to 20 PSI and then start deflation.
- 2. Once tire reaches race pressure (6 PSI for big tires and 12 PSI for small tires) use 1/4" wide measuring tape and place it around center of the tire.
- 3. If they are within 1/2" of each other the tires are a match; if you wish to get them closer take the smaller one back up to 25 PSI let sit for one minute; deflate and measure again.
- 4. If tires are 3/4" or more off in circumference they will need to be swapped out.
