

Part # 635 90-94 Mazda 323/Protégé

O.E.M. REPLACEMENT BAR

NOTE: This bar was designed as an O.E.M. replacement bar. For ease of installation back vehicle up onto car ramps.

- Step 1. Remove O.E.M. bar and retain the bolts from the mid-section brackets.
- Step 2. Lubricate the inside of D-bushings and place them around the midsection of the bar near the arms that point forward. Place the slot/tab brackets over the D-bushings and maneuver the tabs of the bracket into the slots of the chassis. Start the bolt through the bracket and place 3 of the flat washers between the bracket and the bottom of the chassis. Start bolt into chassis and leave loose for now. Repeat for other side.
- Now assemble end-links so as to connect the eye of the bar to the lower suspension arm. NOTE: Using a bench grinder or other means remove the nipples on the end-link bushings that go on either side of the lower control arm so as to allow the bushings to seat.
- Step 4. Tighten end-links so that you can no longer rotate tube spacers.

 NOTE: Over tightening end-links will cause end-link failure!!!! Now tighten bolts that hold the mid-section brackets to 30 ft/lbs.
- Step 5. After installation is complete, check the movement of the suspension and bar for interference with each other and/or with other parts.

 Road test your vehicle to familiarize yourself with its new handling.
