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INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Start by standing the strut upright and extending the piston rod fully.
- 2. Slide the coil-over sleeve over the strut body. The sleeve will rest within the spring seat perch just above the brackets for the steering knuckle.
- 3. Thread the lock nut down to the bottom of the threads of the sleeve. The small raised shoulder will face upwards.
- 4. Thread the spring seat down the sleeve towards the bottom just above the lock nut.
- 5. Apply anti-seize to one side of the spring seat washer. Slide it over the strut and place the side with the anti-seize down on the spring seat.
- 6. Apply anti-seize on the threads of the coil-over sleeve above the spring seat assembly. Failure to do so may result in damage to the sleeve.
- 7. Place the spring over the strut and rest it on the spring seat assembly.
- 8. Slide the spring cap over the strut shaft until it stops.
- 9. Place the thrust bearing assembly on top of the spring cap. One of the thrust washers will sit on the spring cap first. The Torrington bearing will then sit on top of this washer. The second washer will then be installed on top of the thrust bearing.
- 10. Slide the bearing retainer cap over the strut shaft and center it on the thrust bearing assembly.
