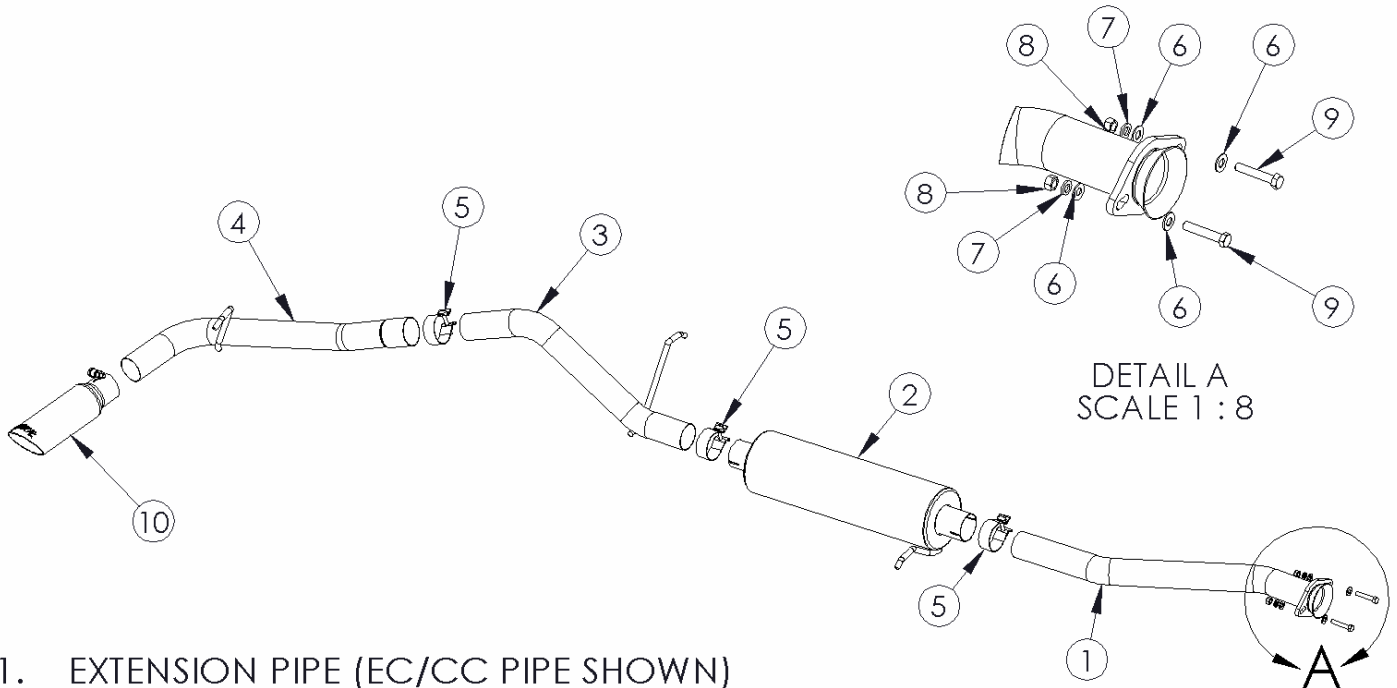

### Removal of Stock System:

1. Apply a penetrating lubricant liberally to all exhaust fasteners, hangers and rubber insulators.

2. Cut the exhaust in front of the muffler so that it can be removed from the vehicle. **Refer to Figure 1.**

3. Remove the nuts from the studs holding the front flange together and disconnect the exhaust system. **Refer to Figure 2. Do not discard nuts as they are required for the installation.**

4. Remove the hangers from the rubber insulators. Remove the exhaust from the vehicle. **Refer to Figure 3.**

### Installation of MBRP Inc. Performance Exhaust:

1. Install the **Extension Pipe** to the existing flange using the fasteners provided. **Refer to Figure 4.**

2. Slide a **Clamp** over the **Extension Pipe** and install the **Muffler** onto the **Extension Pipe**. Attach the **Muffler** to the existing rubber insulator. **Refer to Figure 5.**

3. Slide a **Clamp** over the outlet side of the **Muffler**. Position the **Over Axle Pipe** and loosely attach it to the **Muffler**. Install the **Over Axle Pipe** hanger into the existing rubber insulator. **Refer to Figure 6.**

4. Slide a **Clamp** over the **Tail Pipe** and install onto the **Over Axle Pipe**. Refer to **Figure 7**.

5. Slide the **Tail Pipe** hanger into rearmost rubber insulator. Refer to **Figure 7**.

6. Install and adjust the **Exhaust Tip** to suit. Using a 17mm wrench tighten the lock bolt located on the **Exhaust Tip**. Refer to **Figure 8**.

7. Align the exhaust as required. Starting at the front of the exhaust, tighten all clamps and connections.

8. Check along the whole length of the exhaust system to ensure that there is adequate clearance around the spare tire, fuel and brake lines or any wiring. If any interference is detected relocate or adjust.
