# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- STEP 1: Chock front wheels and jack up vehicle.
- STEP 2: Place jack stands under frame rails.
- STEP 3: With vehicle on stands, use floor jack to support rear suspension.
- STEP 4: Remove rear track bar bolt.
- STEP 5: Disconnect upper sway bar end links.
- STEP 6: Disconnect ABS lines to avoid damage.
- STEP 7: Remove lower shock mounting hardware.
- STEP 8: Lower axle with floor jack and remove stock coil spring and stock rubber coil isolator.
- STEP 9: Use included hardware to fasten new spacer to upper mount location and tighten.
- STEP 10: Re-install stock rubber isolator and coil spring.
- STEP 11: Raise suspension.
- STEP 12: Reattach shock in lower mount.
- STEP 13: Reinstall upper sway bar end links and track bar bolt.
- STEP 14: Reconnect ABS lines.
- STEP 15: Lower vehicle.

### **POST-INSTALLATION**

- STEP 1: Check for proper torque on all fasteners.
- STEP 2: Readjust headlights to proper alignment.

MAINTENANCE: After 500 miles, re-torque all fasteners. (Recommended every 1000 miles thereafter) Have all suspension, driveline and steering components inspected buy a certified technician durning routine maintenance (Recommended every 3000 miles)
