## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- STEP 1: Chock tires to avoid vehicle roll. Jack up vehicle so that wheels are just off the ground.
- STEP 2: Remove all lug nuts. (Socket wrench)
- STEP 3: Remove wheels/tires.
- STEP 4: Check for factory retaining clips and remove if present. Wheel spacer must sit flat against the rotor. Vibrations may occur if clips are not removed from wheel studs.
- STEP 5: Install wheel spacers on studs. Secure with supplied lug nuts and tighten to factory specs. (Torque wrench) DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN
- **STEP 6:** Re-install wheels/tires.
- STEP 7: Re-install factory lug nuts and tighten to factory specs. (Torque wrench) DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN

# POST-INSTALLATION

MAINTENANCE: Wheel lug nuts should be re-tightened to factory torque specs. periodically. Always inspect components and re-tighten lug nuts durning routine service.
